## 4. FIRST AID MEASURES

### Description of first aid measures

<b>General advice</b>	Immediate medical attention is required.
<b>Eye contact</b>	Keep eye wide open while rinsing. Do not rub affected area. Call a physician immediately. In case of contact with substance, immediately flush eyes with running water for at least 30 minutes.

### Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed

Burning sensation. Redness.

### Indication of any immediate medical attention and special treatment needed

Product is a corrosive material. Use of gastric lavage or emesis is contraindicated. Possible perforation of stomach or esophagus should be investigated. Do not give chemical antidotes. Asphyxia from glottal edema may occur. Marked decrease in blood pressure may occur with moist rales, frothy sputum, and high pulse pressure. Treat symptomatically.
